Dr. Carol Dochen Professional Development Scholarship

TADE awards one or more \$500 scholarships each year for professional development. Recipients must be a TADE member in good standing and members may only win one award per year. Awards must be used for professional development within one year. Professional development may include a project or research not funded at the applicant's institution or for professional travel or conference attendance not funded or fully funded at the applicant's institution. This award may not count toward degree research.

** Applications must be sent to the current TADE President within the dates posted to the members and on the CASP listserv. No late applications will be accepted.

** Recipients are required to write a report reflecting how monies were used, which will be shared with TADE members either via the CASP Newsletter, or at a state or national meeting. Reports should be submitted to the current TADE President.

This professional development award is named for Dr. Carol Dochen, who was a key founder of CASP, served as the first and second president of TxCRLA, and chaired five popular CASP Conferences. Dr. Dochen has attended every conference since the first Austin event, and she is the official historian of the organization. She is the Director of the Student Learning Assistance Center at Texas State University-San Marcos where she also teaches in University College and the Department of Educational Administration and Psychological Services.
